ECOADVENTURE CAMP

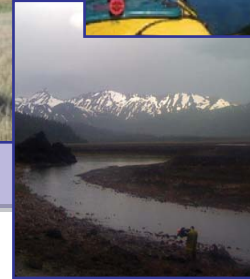
