**Booking and Reservation Information**

**Alaska Coastal Ecology and Winter Ecology Programs**

Alaska Coastal Ecology and Onboard Oceanography Programs are available from August-October of 2011 and April-June of 2012. We are currently accepting reservations for Fall 2011 and we will begin accepting reservation requests for Alaska Coastal Ecology Programs for Spring 2012 on **September 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 a.m.** by fax or email. Reservations will be taken on a first come, first serve bases and you will receive a confirmation letter setting your official trip date within three weeks of submitting your request form.

Alaska Coastal Ecology programs are available at the CACS Peterson Bay Field Station and at the NOAA/UAF Kasitsna Bay Laboratories. The semi-remote Peterson Bay Field Station facilities include classroom space, microscope lab, and kitchen and can accommodate groups of 32 in 4 heated yurts. More information can be found at [www.akcoastalstudies.org](http://www.akcoastalstudies.org). The Kasitsna Bay Laboratory facilities provide a large kitchen, a bunkhouse that sleeps 32, and use of the research laboratory. More information can be found at <http://www.westnurc.uaf.edu/kbay.html>. Overnight programs include lodging, boat transportation, and quality environmental education programming. Groups are responsible for providing for their own food and bedding.

Reservations for residential Winter Ecology programs need to be received by November 1, 2012. These programs will be held at the Ageya Wilderness Camp, <http://ageya.org/>, adjacent to the Wynn Nature Center on the bluff above Homer. The lodge offers full kitchen facilities and can accommodate a group of 30 with sleeping mats in the classroom. Four twenty-foot, heated yurts that sleep eight are also available for overnight stays at a slightly higher per person rate. Overnight programs include facility use, lodging, and quality environmental education programming.

**Confirmation and Deposit Information**

**Field Trip Date Confirmation**

Expect field trip date confirmation within three weeks of submitting your reservation request. It is very important to notify the CACS office immediately if there is a problem with the assigned field trip date.

**Deposits**

A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is due for each Alaska Coastal Ecology, Oceanography, or Winter Ecology program (\$200 for the Combination Program) within 30 days of receiving your Field Trip Date Confirmation. If needed, curriculum materials will be sent upon receipt of deposit. If the deposit is not made by the 30-day deadline, the trip dates will be offered to classes on our waiting list. An additional \$200 deposit is due 60 days after receipt of your trip confirmation. In the event of a cancellation, \$200 of your deposit will be refunded if the cancellation takes place before February 1. The cancellation fee will be refunded if the reservation can be replaced.
