# ECOADVENTURE CAMP

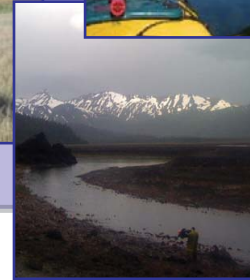
