*Randomly toss your group's wire ring it into the area selected by the instructor.
Carefully move to the bio-ring and use a field guide to complete this worksheet.
Do not move the bio-ring until the survey is completed.*

Using the field guide and your knowledge, identify as many organisms within the ring as you can:

Describe and draw a rough sketch for any organisms you are unable to identify:

What is the overall biodiversity count within your ring?

What organism is most common within your ring?

Are there any types of fungus within your ring? If so, what are they?

Are there any types of lichen within your ring? If so, what are they?

Are there any animals or evidence of animals within your ring? If so, what are they?

What is the largest organism in your ring?

What is the smallest organism within your ring?

What, in your opinion, are the most interesting organisms within your ring?
